

HOME DISCIPLESHIP CATECHISM TEACHING PLAN

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- **The Goal:** The goal of this Teaching Plan is to help your child understand each question, and to memorize the entire catechism as a whole in one year.
- **How it works:**
 - Each month is assigned four or five questions.
 - At the beginning of the week, teach one of the questions for that month.
 - Every day review all the questions for that month. See the example below under “Month 1: Questions 1-4). Note: Some weeks you will need to teach two questions rather than just one.
 - The Teaching Plan assumes that you are also using a Bible storybook, devotional, or Bible Reading Plan. While this catechism covers the essential doctrines, it is not meant to be the only thing you teach your kids.
 - The Teaching Plan also assumes that you are having Bible Time several days a week. (For example, Monday-Thursday evenings.)
- **The Teaching Plan:**
 1. Month 1: Questions 1-4
 - a. Week 1:
 - i. At the beginning of the week, teach Question 1. (This will be the Bible lesson for that day.)
 - ii. This can be done at the beginning or end of Bible Time.
 - b. Week 2:
 - i. At the beginning of the week, teach Question 2.
 - ii. Every day review Questions 1-4 by reading the questions, and then reciting the answers.
 - c. Week 3:
 - i. At the beginning of the week, teach Question 3.
 - ii. Every day review Questions 1-4 by reading the questions, and then reciting the answers.
 - d. Week 4:
 - i. At the beginning of the week, teach Question 3.
 - ii. Every day review Questions 1-4 by reading the questions, and then reciting the answers.
 2. Month 2: Questions 5-8

4. Month 4: Questions 14-17
5. Month 5: Questions 18-21
6. Month 6: Questions 22-25
7. Month 7: Questions 26-29
8. Month 8: Questions 30-34
