Stand Firm — Week 5

**ICEBREAKER:** What has frustrated you in the recent past? Explain.

**OVERVIEW:** Times have sure changed. What used to be bad is now good, and what used to be good is now bad. Take everything you thought you knew about sex and gender and throw it out the window. There are no more rules, no more standards, and no more morals. Anything goes. The only thing that's not allowed is the traditional Christian view of sex and gender. How can we stand firm on God's word in this strange new world of sexual confusion and perversion?

1. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be the most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling? Explain. (Or what was your key takeaway from Sunday's message?)
2. How would you describe the predominant view of sexual morality in America today?
3. How did America come to abandon the sexual morality of its Judeo-Christian heritage?
4. Why does it matter that our country's moral values have shifted away from the Bible?
5. Read Matthew 19:3-6. When asked a question about morality, where did Jesus turn for answers? Why is it important to let the Bible determine your sexual ethics?

6. Why are your feelings, emotions, and even your intellect not sufficient moral guides?
7. Why are majority opinion and the law of the land not sufficient guides to morality?
8. Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17. What are the different ways the Bible helps us?
9. Matthew 19:4 says, "Haven't you read," he replied, "that he who created them in the beginning..." If people are both created by God and made in His image, then what does that teach us about morality?
10. Matthew 19:4 says, "Haven't you read," he replied, "that he who created them in the beginning made them male and female." What does this verse teach us about gender? How does this verse help people who experience gender confusion? Is it immoral to change your gender? Explain.
11. Read Matthew 19:4-5. What does this passage say about same-sex marriage? Should same-sex marriage be legal? Explain.
12. Read Matthew 19:3-6 again. What does this verse teach about homosexual relationships?
13. What can we do to stand firm against sexual liberation?
