DISCUSSION GUIDE

ICEBREAKER: What's missing in your life? What one thing would make your life complete?

OVERVIEW: When you get saved, God doesn't immediately call you away to heaven. He leaves you hear on earth for a while. So now that you're a Christian, how are you supposed to live? Being a Christian is not just a matter of believing, it is a matter of living; of acting; of behaving. In this study we will go deeper with how we're supposed to live now that we're Christians?
