DISCUSSION GUIDE

Why You Need a Pastor Titus—Wk 1

ICEBREAKER: Where are you going?

OVERVIEW: The Bible is clear that every church needs a pastor — to set an example, to manage the church, to teach the church, and to guard it against false teaching. And if the church needs a pastor, and you are a part of the church, then that means you need a pastor in your life. This week we are studying what the Bible says about the role and responsibilities of a pastor so that the pastor can better do his job, and so that we can better encourage and support the pastor in his leadership of the church.

- 1. **Read Titus 1:1-16**. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be the most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling? Explain. (Or what was your key takeaway from Sunday's message?)
- 2. Tell about how God has used a pastor in a significant way to help you grow in Christ (does not have to be Pastor Andy)?
- 3. Why does the church need a pastor?
- 4. The Pastoral Epistles strongly emphasize that pastors must have impeccable character (1 Timothy 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-9). Why is this so important?

- 5. Read 1 Peter 5:1-3. What commands are given to the elders? What does Peter mean by "not overseeing out of compulsion"? What does he mean by "not lording it over those entrusted to you"?
- 6. 1 Peter 5:1-3 exhorts pastors to be an example to the flock. How has the example of the a pastor or other mature Christians impacted you?
- 7. Did you know that other church members are watching you? Is your example inspiring them to grow, or discouraging them?
- 8. The church also needs a pastor for teaching (Titus 1:9). What is something very helpful that you learned from a sermon? What can you do to get the most out of a sermon? Do you think it is important to bring your Bible and take notes in church? Explain.
- 9. Another reason the church needs a pastor is to guard the church from false teaching (Titus 1:9-13). What are some common false teachings threatening the church in American today? What can the pastor do to protect the church from false teaching?
- 10. The pastor's calling is to lead, feed, and protect the church. How can you better support your pastor?

The Last Word: If you want to have a healthy spiritual life, then plug into the church (don't be a lone-ranger Christian; a solo Christian), and place yourself under the leadership of a godly pastor.
