The Third Commandment
The Ten Commandments — Week 5



Exodus 20:4-7 (CSB) “Do not misuse the name of the LORD your God, because the LORD will not leave anyone unpunished who misuses his name.”

Matthew 12:36 (CSB) “I tell you that on the day of judgment people will have to account for every careless word they speak.”

Leviticus 24:13-16
13 Then the Lord spoke to Moses: 14 “Bring the one who has cursed to the outside of the camp and have all who heard him lay their hands on his head; then have the whole community stone him. 15 And tell the Israelites: If anyone curses his God, he will bear the consequences of his sin. 16 Whoever blasphemes the name of the Lord must be put to death; the whole community is to stone him. If he blasphemes the Name, he is to be put to death, whether the resident alien or the native.

1. What does the third commandment _____ ?

Exodus 3:15 “God also said to Moses, ‘Say this to the Israelites: The LORD, the God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This is my name forever; this is how I am to be remembered in every generation.’”

Exodus 15:3 “The LORD is a warrior; the LORD is his name.”

Exodus 34:5 “The LORD came down in a cloud, stood with him there, and proclaimed his name, “the LORD.””

Isaiah 42:8 “I am the LORD. That is my name, and I will not give my glory to another or my praise to idols.”

Exodus 3:14 “God replied to Moses, ‘I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: I AM has sent me to you.’”
