DISCUSSION GUIDE

ICEBREAKER: If you could go anywhere for a one-day visit, where would you go? Why?

OVERVIEW: This month marks the 47th anniversary of Roe v. Wade, the infamous Supreme Court case that forced legalized abortion on the entire country. Since that time, millions of unborn children have been murdered. But abortion isn't just murder, it is the violation of each of the Ten Commandments. In this discussion we will go deeper with the evil of abortion and learn how to better defend the unborn.

- 2. Read Exodus 20:3-4. How does abortion violate the first and second commandments?
- 3. Read Exodus 20:7-8. How does abortion violate the third and fourth commandments?
- 4. Read Exodus 20:12-13. How does abortion violate the fifth and sixth commandments?
- 5. Read Exodus 20:14-15. How does abortion violate the seventh and eighth commandments?

- 6. Read Exodus 20:16-17. How does abortion violate the ninth and tenth commandments?
- 7. If abortion violates all of the Ten Commandments, then why do some people still argue for it to be legal? How would you answer these arguments?

- 9. What can you personally do to more actively and effectively advocate for the rights of the unborn?
