*WHY DO PEOPLE GO TO HELL?* The Gospel of John — Week 11

5. According to John 3:17-21, who goes to hell, sinners or unbelievers? Explain. ICEBREAKER: What are you thankful for today? **OVERVIEW:** The doctrine of hell is one of the most hated doctrines in the Bible. How could an all-loving, all-knowing, all-powerful God send people to hell? This question has caused many Christians to ignore the clear teaching of the Bible, or to fall away from the faith altogether. But the Bible is abundantly clear about 6. Read Matthew 12:31-32. What is the unforgivable sin? hell. It is the place of eternal torment inhabited by those who reject God's offer of salvation by grace through faith in Jesus Christ.
