## **DISCUSSION GUIDE**

ICEBREAKER: What are you thankful for today?

**OVERVIEW**: The Christian life is hard. In fact, it is impossible. We are expected to love God wholeheartedly, love our neighbor selflessly, evangelize fearlessly, give hilariously, and live obediently. - 1. **Read John 7:37-39**. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be the most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling? Explain. (Or what was your key takeaway from Sunday's message?)
- 2. Who is the Holy Spirit?
- 3. How does the Holy Spirit compare to "streams of living water"?
- 4. What are some of the ways the Holy Spirit wants to work in your life?

- 5. Read Ephesians 5:18. What does it mean to be filled with the Holy Spirit, and how do we obey this command?
- 6. Read Ephesians 4:29-32. What does it mean to "grieve God's Holy Spirit"? What are some ways that we grieve the Spirit of God? Why is it essential that we do not grieve the Spirit?
- 7. Read 1 Thessalonians 5:19. What does it mean to quench the Spirit? What are some ways that we can quench the Spirit?
- 8. Read Ephesians 5:18-21. What are the marks of a Spirit-filled believer?
- 9. What are some common misunderstandings about the Holy Spirit that you would want new believers know?
