## **DISCUSSION GUIDE**

ICEBREAKER: What's your favorite ice-cream brand and flavor?

**OVERVIEW**: Worship. The Bible makes a big deal out of it. We are commanded to do it. We think we understand it. But do we? Do we worship in a way that truly glorifies God? Do we give ourselves in worship the way God wants us to? When we consider who Jesus is and what He has done, is doing, and promises to do, there is only one right response: worship. - 2. What does it say about Jesus that He allowed the man to worship Him?
- 3. What is worship?
- 4. Why should we worship God?

- 5. Read Nehemiah 9:1-5. The entire nation assembled for worship. How did they worship God?
- 6. Read Romans 12:1. What does this verse teach about worship?
- 7. What do you need to do to improve your times of private worship?
- 8. What do you need to do to improve your worship when we gather as a church?
- 9. Can corporate worship be a witness to the lost? Explain?
