THE TRIUMPH OF GOD OVER THE SIN OF MAN
Stand-alone Sermon

ICEBREAKER: What is the ideal age to get married? Why?

OVERVIEW: As the Canadian government enacts a new law this month prohibiting young people from seeking or receiving help to overcome same-sex attraction and gender dysphoria, Church Acadiana is standing up and speaking out. Homosexuality is a sin. God can change people. People need to hear the truth. And the government has no business interfering with religious exercise and free speech. In this discussion we will go deeper with how the Church should handle the current cultural acceptance of homosexuality and rejection of Biblical truth.

1. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be the most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling? Explain. (Or what was your key takeaway from Sunday's message?)
2. Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-11. What can we learn about homosexuality from this passage?
3. Why is it important for people to know the truth about homosexuality?
4. What are the inevitable consequences of a government prohibiting conversion therapy for young people?

5. How should Christians in Canada respond to this new law?
6. What can we do to help the Christians in Canada?
7. Read Romans 1:21-27.
 - a. What causes people to turn to homosexuality?
 - b. What words does Paul use to describe homosexuality?
 - c. How does this passage dictate how Christians must view and respond to homosexuality?
