DISCUSSION GUIDE

ICEBREAKER: If you found an abandoned car with \$50,000 in the back seat, what would you do?

OVERVIEW: In Revelation 18 the world mourns the destruction of Babylon the Great — a symbol of first century Jerusalem. God's people are commanded not to join in the funeral dirge, but to rejoice at the destruction of God's enemy. In Revelation 19 we find God's people doing just that. Their obedience leads us into a discussion of the importance of obedience to the Christian life.
