DISCUSSION GUIDE

ICEBREAKER: If you are at the zoo, what animal do you enjoy watching most and why?

OVERVIEW: For a lot of people, God plays a small part in their life. They may believe in God, go to church, and ask God for help when they run into hard times, but other than that God doesn't really impact their daily life. But this week we are studying a story that reveals the role that God actually wants to play in your life. In short, He wants to be first. And this is what faith is all about — putting God first in your life.

- e. What is the promise in this passage, and what does it mean?
- 6. Read Hebrews 11:17-19 and refer to Sunday's sermon for the following questions.
 - a. This story is about God testing Abraham. What does the Bible teach about tests / trials?
 - b. What did God tell Abraham to do in this story?
 - c. How did Abraham respond to God's command?
 - d. How did Abraham put God first in this story?
 - e. What changes do you need to make to start putting God first in your life?
