## **DISCUSSION GUIDE**

ICEBREAKER: What's something about you that no one knows?

**OVERVIEW**: In public schools and universities across America, Christian students are taught that human beings evolved from ape-like creatures. This directly contradicts the Bible's account of creation. On top of this, students are taught that Darwinian Evolution is a settled fact that has been proven in the lab. This lie is causing many people to doubt the truthfulness of the Bible. After all, if the first chapters of the Bible are wrong, then maybe the rest of it is too. In this discussion we will go deeper with some of the giant holes in Darwinian Evolution and see why the theory doesn't hold water.
