DISCUSSION GUIDE

ICEBREAKER: If you could rule the world for one day, what would you do?

OVERVIEW: Your beliefs determine your behavior, and your beliefs about God impact you more than anything else. This is why it is so important for Christians to believe sound doctrine. One of the best tools for learning sound doctrine is the Apostles' Creed, an ancient summary of Christian belief. In this study we will go deeper with the words of the Creed, "I believe in God the Father."

- 6. Recite the Apostles' Creed Together: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth; I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
